

Tips for Board Examinations

1. On the night before the examination, sleep early so that you get up early after getting at least 7 hours of sleep.
2. On the morning of the examination, go through your daily routine in a relaxed manner. Pray to God for good performance if you believe in Him.
3. Tell yourself, "Whatever the paper is likely to be, I will do it, and I have the confidence to do it. And I am sure that I can score excellent marks."
4. Go through the question paper twice, not once. Identify the questions that are easy for you and the ones that are difficult.
5. Relax for 2 minutes before you start writing the answer. First always go for questions, which you are sure of.
6. After doing all the easy questions, relax again for 2 minutes. Then go for detailed and difficult questions. Don't leave difficult questions unanswered. Write whatever possible points you can. Marks are given, even for one or two simple steps.
7. The best way to present an answer is to give a precise, relevant answer with all the relevant steps/explanations. CBSE is very particular that the answers are to the point.
8. The paper should be very clear, neat, and with important points underlined. Overwriting/striking puts off the person who corrects the paper, so avoid doing it.
9. Mention the Question number clearly while answering. Mention the subpart of the question clearly if the question has more than one part.
10. Handwriting makes a great difference in scoring of marks. Proper spacing is very important to draw any legible diagrams.
11. You have to revise before you submit your paper to avoid silly mistakes. Revising is better for mathematics, if you have time. Before submitting the papers sit for 2 minutes and try to recollect the answer.
